STRAWBERRY PLANTS

All our strawberry plants are entered for certification and are de-blossomed in early spring therefore they are not let pollinate and are only for plant production. They are grown from elite and super elite stocks in virgin soil.

Cambridge Favourite

(Early Cropper)

High yields of very good flavoured fruit. Very reliable old variety. Good resistance to verticillium, wilt and mildew. Easy to grow. The best variety for bad conditions eg. soils, weather, delay in picking, they still hold their flavour and appearance for at least one week after ripening.

Symphony

(Late Cropper) (Available on request)

A most popular late variety, fruiting up to the end of July. Very good resistance to Red Core. Heavy cropper.

Eros

(Mid Season) (Available on request)

An alternative variety to Elsanta, with good resistance to Red Core with large fruit. Good in suspect ground.

Hapil

Justifiably popular choice for many years for amateur growers, this is a large vigorous mid-season plant, good flavour and easy to pick because of its size. Original Belgian variety with soft glossy bright red berries.

Elsanta

(Mid Crop)

Elsanta plants which produce large glossy, firm orange red fruit. Very popular for fresh fruit markets. Suitable for protected and outdoor cropping, ripening out of doors about the middle of June. Capable of high yields and crops well in its maiden year. Poor disease resistance in suspect ground.

Elsanta is a sensitive variety and needs to have good soil conditions. Susceptible to Verticillium Wilt. Elsanta is less suitable for cultivation in soil in which potatoes or strawberries have been grown before.

Early season varieties

Malling Jewel

The most consistent producer under any conditions for over 50 years. It has a good resistance to diseases. It will tolerate wet land and is very reliable. It is dark in colour due to its richness and has a long fruiting season which starts the first week of July.

Mid-season

Glen Ample

A mid-season variety of large fleshy fruit of excellent flavour. The cane is upright and the yields are heavy with berries suitable for all uses.

Cascade Delight

Delicious raspberries, Cascade delight, are very easy to grow. They can be eaten straight from the plant, used in jams, summer puddings, coulis and wine, and they also freeze well. It has good resistance to root rot, making it ideal for growing in heavy soils.

Tulameen Pearl

Attractive, large, glossy berries with a firm texture and superb flavour. A strong, vigorous mid season variety.

Autumn Fruiterers

These are popular because they require no support and all canes are pruned down to the ground in late winter, thus keeping labour to a minimum and will fruit on new canes next season and do not need to be confined to rows.

Autumn Bliss

This variety fruits during late August, September and October. It has good flavour, high yields and exceptionally large fruit, with a good resistance to Phytophthora. The same as all other Autumn varieties. Most consistent grower and has outclassed other Autumn varieties.

Polana

Early variety autumn fruiting Raspberry. Good yields of sweet, medium/large, glossy berries. Suitable for cooking, freezing and eating fresh from the cane. Good disease resistance and resistant to cold.

Polka

An autumn fruiting raspberry with the potential to provide two crops - producing deep red berries with a sweet flavour.

All Gold

This Autumn fruiter produces high yields of yellow fruit with good flavour. A much improved cultivar. Similar yields to Autumn Bliss.

A consistent grower and fruiter and most popular. Cross between raspberry and blackberry Medana, this is a virus free strain, capable of very good yields with a delicious sweet Loganberry taste.

A Tayberry cross with large dark red fruit. Later than Tayberries.

Sunberries

LY59 is the variety we find easiest to grow, still quite thorny, with a sharp taste. Excellent for jam making, pies etc.

RHUBARB

Timperley Early

A very early, hardy variety and by far the most popular heavy yielding variety. Good disease resistant and very easy to establish, small amounts can be harvested at the end of its first year. Care must be taken not to disturb the stools in the ground if pulling. When fully established from the 2nd year on, plantations produce well for up to ten years.

Champagne

Recognised as one of the best for forcing, the slender stems turn a beautiful shade of pink with a sweet taste. Unforced, the flavours are just as delicious with dark red stems. An old variety which is very easy to grow. Perfect for jams, pies and desserts.

Victoria

This is an old variety that was introduced in 1837. Good stick quality and flavour with high yields. Easy to grow.

GOOSEBERRIES

Black Velvet

Black Velvet produces berries which are small to medium-sized with a deep purplish-red colour. Excellent sweet tart flavour. Can be eaten fresh when fully ripe. The bush is vigorous and upright in habit with very good disease resistance.

Invicta

Suitable for commercial growers, this is the best variety available at the moment because of its good resistance to mildew and its very high yields. Fruit is pale green and is used for cooking and also desserts when ripe. Harvesting time early/mid July.

Hinonnmaki Yellow

A mid-season very hardy variety bred in Finland. Good mildew resistant yellow fruiting variety that would need support.

Hinonnmaki Red

A hardy mid season, dark red fruiting variety and a heavy cropper of medium sized fruit.

Hinonnmaki Green

Mid-season, mildew resistant, larger than average fruit. Can be eaten fresh and perfect for jams, jellies and pies. Attractive bright green foliage turning yellow in autumn. Easy to grow and care for.

BLACKBERRIES

Loch Ness

Most widely planted spike free variety of Blackberry. Early to mid season. Winter hardy with good yields of fruit. Train and prune like summer fruiting raspberry. Very popular, good flavoured fruit.

Vigorous plant with thick, strong stems. Late ripening.
Other varieties available: Waldo, Chester.

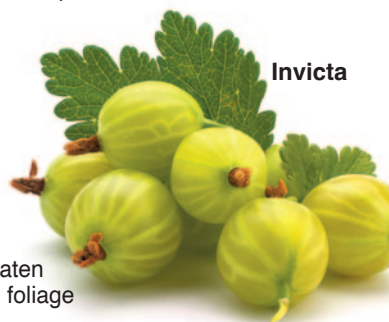

BLACKCURRANTS

Ben Connon (Early cropper)

This is a Ben Sarek and Ben Lomond cross with high yields of large fruit. Good resistance to mildew.

Ben Sarek (Early cropper)

Very high yielding variety with large fruit and easy to pick. Compact bushes with good frost and mildew resistance.

Ben Tirran (Late cropper)

High yielding, late ripening variety. The fruit size is medium to small but the yields are much greater than Ben Lomond.

Titania

Mid-season variety. Easy to grow. High juice content for jams and juices.

Ebony

Early variety. Exceptionally sweet blackcurrant, large fruit. Can be eaten fresh from the bush.

WHITECURRANTS

Blanka

A high yielding variety of large berries and long trusses. The most popular variety at the moment, easy to grow.

White Dutch (White Hollander)

A mid season variety with wonderful sweet flavour fruit.

REDCURRANTS

Jonkheer-Van-Tets

An early cropper with heavy yields. The bright red fruit is juicy and rated very highly for flavour. Growth is upright and vigorous.

Junifer

A very early variety, heavy yielder, easy to pick. It crops on both 2 year old and 1 year old timber.

Rovada

A late flowering, late fruiting variety with very dark red large fruit. Its cropping capacity appears to be exceptional. Flavour is good. Fruit stores exceptionally well for long periods.

Mid-season variety, easy to grow.

Goji (*Lycium Barbarum*)

The Goji fruit is a berry found originally in the Himalayas. It has small red berries that grow on small bushes. Goji's were used thousands of years ago by Chinese herbalists for improving energy, sexual health and vitality.

Fruits taste like cranberries and are used for syrups and preserves. Grown best in acidic soil. Plant used for ground cover under trees, large shrubs and on banks for ground cover.

GRAPE VINES

Schonburger (Bareroot)

This outdoor green variety, successfully grown in Ireland, produces pinkish fruit which is very good for winemaking and is also suitable for dessert. Pick mid-October.

Black Hamburg (Bareroot)

By far the most popular greenhouse grape. A black grape, easiest to grow. Fruits freely.

Alicante (Bareroot)

The Black Alicante grape is one of the tastiest grape varieties. A hardy, deciduous plant with a climbing habit. When grown outdoors they prefer a sheltered spot in a south facing location. They can also be grown in a greenhouse.

Zilga (P9 Pot) - Blue Grape

Vigorous, woody vines bearing sweet, juicy dark blue/black fruit. Cold resistant, with high resistance to mould and mildew.

Mika (P9 Pot) - Blue Grape

Hardy early season grape. A mild, sweet tasting with a hint of blueberry.

Beta (P9 Pot) - Blue Grape

Mid-season, self fertile grape. A winter hardy variety.

BLUEBERRIES

Blueberries will flourish in free-draining, acidic soil. To ensure best yields it is recommended to have P.H. 4.0-5.5 and at least two varieties for pollination purposes.

Blue Crop

Most popular variety in this country. Early to mid season. Heavy cropper, with upright growth. Very good flavour.

Patriot

An early season hardy plant with spreading habits. Fiery Red to orange foliage in Autumn.

Duke

An early season variety, Duke has a mild flavour, producing high yields of blueberries.

Herbert

A late season variety. Very winter hardy, jumbo sized fruit.

Chandler

Produces large, light blue, sweetly flavoured berries that hang in clusters.

Pink Lemonade

The first pink blueberry. A delicious sweet beautiful pink blueberry to eat and attractive ornamental white-pink flowers in Spring and crisp orange foliage in Autumn. Self pollinating.

Earliblue (New for this year)

An early season variety. Very winter hardy, jumbo sized fruit.

Torro

A heavy producer of large fruit, self fertile with red foliage in the autumn.

Spartan

An early season, light blue berry, upright robust variety, can reach 2m high.

Hannah's Choice

Early season. Large berries with a sweet peachy taste and firm texture.

Brigitta Blue

A late season variety, ripens the end of August, upright growth.

Elliot

A late season variety, Elliot has a delicate pink tinged flower, followed by firm medium sized blueberries with a robust flavour.

Sweetheart

Early season, heavy cropper. Self-fertile but will always benefit from a pollinator. Dark green foliage, red in the autumn.

Two year old trees, well feathered, ready to go. Trees will flower in its first year and will fruit if conditions are right. Apple trees are selected by professional growers on colour, suitability, with good disease resistance, yields etc. Trees can be planted 3ft apart making them suitable for small gardens and commercial growers.

Idared

A self-fertile eating and cooking variety which produces dark red fruit with white flesh. This is a very fertile good universal pollinator, with a long flowering period and good pollinators. It is also used as an overall pollinator with 6%-10% spread amongst the main varieties. Available on M9 rootstocks.

Jonaprince

Large red flushed apple, honey sweet flavour. Crispy texture, good yields. Fares better when stored for a month or two. Available on M9 rootstocks.

Boskoop

A dual-purpose apple, suitable for both dessert and culinary uses. Mainly used in Europe as a cooking apple. This popular apple has a white to pale green flesh with a crisp texture. It has a tart, dry aromatic flavour. Available on M9 rootstocks.

Gala

A variety grown for its shiny red skin and crisp, sweet flesh. Crops are heavy but should be thinned early to avoid a lot of small apples. Available on M9 rootstocks.

Elstar

A variety which produces fairly large fruit with nice bright red blushing on yellow background. It has an excellent taste with milk white flesh. Harvesting time mid-October. Self-fertile. Very good pollinator for other varieties. Available on M9 rootstocks.

Cevaal

Cevaal (Alkmene) is an attractive medium sized eating apple with yellow skin flushed red. Its compact growth makes it a good choice for small gardens. Partially self Fertile, however will benefit from a pollinator. Alkmene is also referred to as Early Windsor.

The only choice for healthy fertile apple trees.

Cox's Orange Pippin

A popular variety because of its superb flavour but it needs good soil. A golden apple flushed with orange/red and patches of brown russet.

Jonagold

This variety is a triploid and produces best when cross pollinated with two other varieties. Red on a yellow green background, an excellent balance of sharpness and sweetness. Large fruit. Harvest time late September/mid October. Available on M9 rootstocks.

James Grieve

A good choice for a bad site. A hardy variety which crops well and regularly. It is a medium sized dessert apple, yellow in appearance with speckles and stripes and an orange skin.

Elshop

A bright red, new variety, mutant of Elstar. Excellent quality aroma and sugar acidity balance. Highly recommended by English's Fruit Nurseries.

Pinova

A firm late apple with a dark red skin over a yellow background, stores well for months. Crisp and crunchy texture. Pink fragrant white blossom. Highly recommended by English's Fruit Nurseries. This variety is working well in Ireland.

Winston

Winston is a compact, easy to grow tree which is well suited to smaller gardens. Its also partially self-fertile so it does not require a pollinator, however having a compatible partner will help improve fruiting. This eating apple has a great advantage of storing well, as the longer the apples are stored, the sweeter they become.

Egremont Russet

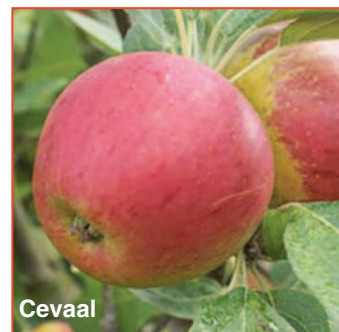
Egremont Russet has a unique nutty flavour. A good regular cropper of yellow/green, russet covered apples. The flesh is cream to pale yellow coloured. Unlike many apples, the Egremont Russet will do well in wet conditions.

Spartan

Spartan is a popular late apple with children due to its small size and sweet flavour. Perfect for eating fresh and juicing, The deep red/purple colour is attractive for any garden.

Due to popular demand we now have available Old Traditional Varieties on large rootstocks on MM106 or M26. The following varieties are available as two year old well feathered trees and are supplied with a coloured label and plant passport.

Beauty of Bath: Beauty of Bath is an early fruiting dessert apple. The fruit typically crops in August or as early as July. Producing medium sized, bright red, juicy apples.

Charles Ross: Charles Ross is a dual purpose apple used for both cooking and fresh eating. Producing large sized, attractive red/orange striped apples. They have an aromatic, sweet and slightly sharp taste. Used for cooking, cider making and juices.

Katy: Katy is an early season variety and produces large quantities of attractive, extremely juicy red apples. The tree itself has an attractive blossom, making it a great addition to your garden. Katy can be used for juicing, cider and fresh eating.

Bramley's Seedling: Bramley produces an abundance of large juicy crops with a cream coloured flesh. Can be used for cooking, juicing and cider making. Bramley is a triploid, so it will need two other varieties for good pollination. Its also referred to as biennial, so it will crop more heavily in alternate years.

Greensleeves: Greensleeves is a mid season variety and an excellent pollinator for other mid season apples. This dessert cultivar produces regular crops of pale green, turning pale yellow apples. It has a creamy white, juicy and soft flesh. A short season of use from late September to October.

James Grieve: James Grieve is a popular mid season eating variety. This dual purpose apple has a pleasant acidity when picked early. Excellent for producing sharp-tasting apple juice or for use in pies and crumbles as it turns sweeter when fully ripe.

Boskoop

A dual-purpose apple, suitable for both dessert and culinary uses. Mainly used in Europe as a cooking apple. This popular apple has a white to pale green flesh with a crisp texture. It has a tart, dry aromatic flavour.

Elstar

Elstar produces medium-sized, bright red fruit with a crisp and juicy flesh. Its has a rich, honeyed flavour, Crops heavily and stores well. Can be used for juicing and fresh eating.

PLUMS

2 YEAR OLD TREES 6-7 FT TALL

CHERRY TREES
